**Primary Care Trust Medical Services (Amendment) Directions
2010**

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 8 and 273(1) of the National Health Service Act 2006(a), gives the following Directions.

Citation, commencement and application

1.—(1) These Directions may be cited as the Primary Care Trust Medical Services (Amendment) Directions 2010 and come into force on 26th May 2010.

(2) In these Directions, “the Primary Care Trust Medical Services Directions 2010” means the Primary Care Trust Medical Services Directions 2010 signed on 13th April 2010(b).

(3) These Directions are given to Primary Care Trusts in England.

Insertion of provision following direction 19 of the Primary Care Trust Medical Services Directions 2010

2. After direction 19 (signing of documents) of the Primary Care Trust Medical Services Directions 2010 insert—


“Terms of service for salaried general medical practitioners employed to provide services from a Practice

19A. Where, a Primary Care Trust offers employment to a general medical practitioner to provide primary medical services in relation to a Practice, it must offer that employment on terms which are no less favourable than those contained in the “Model terms and conditions of service for a salaried general practitioner employed by a Primary Care Trust” published by the British Medical Association and the NHS Confederation as item 1.4 of the supplementary documents to the GMS Contract 2003(c).”.
